Other than the required passes in relevant subjects at GCE "A" Level all applicants must have 'O' Level English Language and Mathematics at grade C or better

CUT-OFF POINTS

In Section 4 CUT-OFF POINTS for the past year are indicated per degree programme merely as simple guidelines to prospective candidates. Cut-off points tend to influence every year.

DURATION OF STUDY

The duration of study indicated in section 4 includes one year of INDUSTRIAL ATTACHMENT.
